

Savings example

The following example shows how participating in Half Tablet can reduce your cost by half, taking the same tablet at the same strength.

Prescribed: 20mg of Crestor per day, 30 tablets, 1-month supply.

Your Current Prescription



Half Tablet Program



Split each 40mg tablet into two 20mg doses.

In this example, you would save \$15.00 per month, or \$180 annually.
Your actual savings will vary based on your medication costs and plan design.

As prescription medication costs continue to increase, you may be searching for ways to lower your costs at the pharmacy. You can save up to 50% on your prescription costs by participating in Half Tablet.

You get the same medication and strength for half the cost

With Half Tablet, you take the same medication at the same strength, yet save money on medications you take on a regular basis – up to hundreds of dollars every year**.

Here's how it works:*



1. **Your doctor** writes a new prescription for twice the strength and half the quantity, noting your intent to split the tablets on your prescription.



2. **A new prescription** is filled and you automatically pay half your usual cost.



3. **Split each tablet** and take half – you get your usual dose for half the cost.

* All medication in italic font are the generic form of the brand medication. Both the brand and generic form qualify for tablet splitting.

For example: If you are currently prescribed 4mg of Aceon, your physician can approve you to split your tablets. Your physician must write a new prescription for 8mg, and you would split each tablet and take only half, equaling the original 4mg dose.
