CHOICE PLUS PLAN WITH HEALTH SAVINGS ACCOUNT

- Same national network as the current UnitedHealthcare benefit plan. *(If you go out of network, your costs may be higher.)*
- There's no need to choose a primary care provider (PCP) or get referrals to see a specialist. *(Consider finding a PCP; they can be helpful in managing your care.)*
- Preventive care is covered at 100% when using a UHC network provider. *(Includes well visits, immunizations, mammograms, colonoscopies, routine labs and more.)*
- Preventive prescription drugs paid at current co-pays. *(Refer to CVS list.)*
- Open a Health Savings Account (HSA) account in 2016, State will fund the entire deductible (\$1500 individual/\$3000 family) to your HSA.
- Participants can make pre-tax contribution through payroll deduction in order to help save for current and future healthcare expenses.
