

Open Enrollment Ends Today!

Open enrollment for the 2023 calendar year ends at midnight tonight. This is your final opportunity to enroll in or make changes to your State of Rhode Island employee benefits plans for next year, unless you have a <u>qualifying status</u> change.

Do You Need to Act Before Open Enrollment Ends?

If you are satisfied with your current benefits elections and you don't want to elect a <u>health care flexible spending account (FSA)</u> or <u>dependent care spending account (DCSA)</u> for 2023, you don't need to enroll. If you don't currently have an FSA or DCSA and you do nothing, all your benefits elections, including <u>medical</u>, <u>dental</u>, <u>vision</u>, <u>life insurance</u>, <u>legal</u>, and <u>short-term disability</u> will

roll over. However, if you want to have an FSA and/or DCSA in 2023, you must enroll by midnight tonight.

Take advantage of the supplemental life insurance enhancement.

This year, you'll be able to add to your supplemental life insurance with a new 2-times-salary coverage option (up to \$300,000). If you currently have supplemental life insurance at 1 times your salary, you can elect the increase to 2 times during open enrollment without having to provide any proof of good health. If you do not have supplemental life insurance yet and you would like to elect it during this year's open enrollment period, you will be subject to The Hartford's evidence of insurability requirements.

Important: Don't Wait Until the Last Minute to Enroll

Although the enrollment system is available until midnight tonight, the Office of Employee Benefits closes today at 4 p.m. If you need help or have benefits and enrollment questions, we will not be available to assist you after that time. Please enroll as early as possible, so that if you have any last-second issues or questions, you will be able to reach us. We anticipate a high volume of phone calls today, so the best way to reach us is via email. Just present your inquiry in this email.
